Computer Hall — A Permanent Home for the Lab

Kivutis Academy's Computer Resource Centre already gives pupils and community members in Ugweri Thau a rare local entry point into digital literacy, but it currently operates from shared, general-purpose space rather than a room built for it. As the programme grows, so does the need for a secure, purpose-built home for the equipment and the lessons run on it.

This proposal funds a dedicated computer hall: a lockable, properly wired masonry room sized to safely house an expanded bank of desktop computers, protect them from dust and power surges, and give pupils a stable, distraction-free environment for typing, coding, and CBC digital-literacy lessons.

We are raising \$12,000 to construct this hall, coordinated directly by Dr. Chris Kivuti and local contractors in Embu. Once built, it becomes the permanent base for the Computer Donation and Computer Support programmes already active at the school. Donors may fund the project in full, give any amount toward it, or contribute to the general infrastructure fund. Gifts over \$1,000 receive a dedication plaque, with dated photo updates shared as construction proceeds.
