Dining Hall — A Sheltered Place to Eat

Right now, pupils at Kivutis Academy eat lunch outdoors or in staggered shifts inside classrooms, weather permitting. As enrolment grows under Kenya's Competency-Based Curriculum, this arrangement is becoming harder to sustain, particularly during Embu's rainy season when there is simply nowhere sheltered for the whole school to sit and eat together.

A dedicated dining hall would let pupils eat seated, sheltered from sun and rain, in a single sitting rather than rotating through classroom space between lessons. It would also free up classrooms currently interrupted by lunch service, restoring lost instructional time.

We are raising \$15,000 for a masonry dining hall sized to seat the school in two sittings, built to the same durable, Ministry-compliant standard as our classroom blocks, and coordinated directly by Dr. Chris Kivuti and local contractors in Embu with no intermediary overhead.

This is the second priority in our seven-part infrastructure campaign, after the urgent Grade 7 classroom block. Donors may fund this project in full, contribute any amount toward it, or give to the general infrastructure fund. Every gift over \$1,000 is recognised with a dedication plaque at the completed hall, and donors receive dated photo updates as construction progresses.

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
